The Rashad M. McClaney Scholarship Fund was established within St. Peter Missionary Baptist Church, Inc. by family, friends and community members in July 2019. This year the scholarship program will award scholarships up to \$1,000 to high school graduates from Bullock, Macon and Pike Counties and who will attend a community college or career technical program of instruction in Alabama. Eligibility

Applicants to the Rashad M. McClaney Memorial Scholarship Fund must:

- Be a graduating senior (current year)
- Have a minimum 2.5 grade point average (GPA)
- Demonstrate community service and participation in extra-curricular activities
- Indicate and prove plans to attend an accredited community college or career technical program of instruction

- Two (2) letters of reference on official letterhead addressing the student's academic promise and character from different sources such as teacher, volunteer coordinator, adult supervisor, employer, etc. Reference letters from parents will not be accepted.

- Two-page, typed, double-spaced essay that details the student's long-term goals and plans for achieving them, as well as how the student will use the "Win the Day 365" mantra in everyday life to support achievement of the goals
- Copy of college or trade school acceptance letter
- Official High School Transcript
